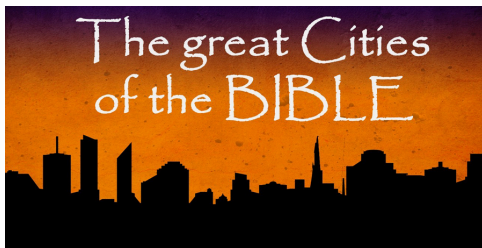

Wednesday LifeGroups

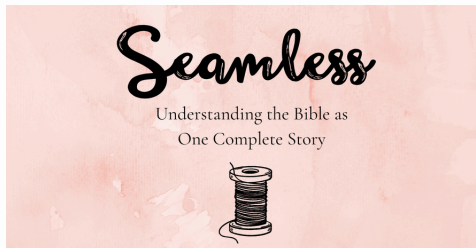
These LifeGroups run from April 2nd - May 21st from 6:30 - 7:30 PM
